### **Parish Summer Outing – Tuesday 8<sup>th</sup> August 2017**

This year, a slightly different choice of venue for our Summer Outing, Bletchley Park 'Home of the Codebreakers'. Travel will be with Greys Coaches, with pick-ups at both Liss and Petersfield. Time at Bletchley Park will be free flow. There will be guidance leaflets available on arrival, but the full guide (normally £5) can be pre-ordered with booking at a discounted £3.50. There are full catering facilities and also lakeside benches for
